TEWANTIN SHIELD 2018 - RULES

- (1) Images previously entered in the Tewantin shield will not be accepted.
- (2) All digital images should be submitted on either CD or DVD.
- (3) Images to be submitted as sRGB jpeg files, using the highest Q12 quality settings. i.e. minimum compression applied.
- (4) The following must be included in each image filename in order, SECTION, IMAGE NO, CLUB NO, TITLE. Separated by underscores.... For example NA_2_10_red fungi.jpg (2nd Nature image out of 5 submitted by Peninsula Club.)
- (5) Nambour Club will be using an Epson Native Full-HD resolution digital projector and Irfanview display software. Hence Maximum image resolution required for best quality full screen projection will be 3x2 ratio format at maximum dimensions 1620 pixels horizontally, and maximum 1080 pixels vertically. Irfanview software will resample resolutions larger than this back to fill the screen, or will display resolutions smaller than this at the actual resolution used by the author.
- (6) Management committee reserves the right to reject any submitted images that are significantly outside this ideal format and resolution.
- (7) There are four sections: People (PE), Pictorial (PI), Nature (NA), Looking down (SS).
- (8) Limit of five (5) Image entries per section, maximum of two entries per person per section allowed.
- (9) There will be 1st place only in each section. The champion image will receive an award.
- (10) All points will be tallied and the overall club with the highest total will be declared the winner of the TEWANTIN SHIELD. Club with lowest points nominates SS for following years Tewantin Shield
- (11) Judging will take place at 7PM on 17th November 2017 at the CWA HALL SHORT STREET, NAMBOUR.
- (12) CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES 5PM FRIDAY 2rd November 2018
